# **Budget Recap**

- \$62,450 is a one time budget expense because there is a surplus
- Annual budget of \$80,425 is more like the year over year budget
- Munchalunch balance and minimum balance (totalling \$35,000) has previously been held outside of the budget to handle start up of Munchalunch, for clarity these are now included in the budget as a opposed to holding them outside of the budget
- When comparing income vs expenses there was budget shortfall of \$11,000 which would normally be the fundraising goal, after Quebec money comes back in and everything is reconciled there will not likely be a shortfall, PAC needs to decide whether or not to fundraise since there needs to be a stated fundraising goal, there is an opportunity to fundraise at later point in the year if we do not go ahead with fundraising right now
