## Diane:

- Garden Program: back and forth with Doug. Still waiting for quotes on school made vs district made planters. Doug is looking into it as well, in his new position.
- Field might get a reseed as early as March, weather permitting, fence will be fixed, is a sand field with gras patches right now.
- Volleyball nets no new information.
- Sambali: they are still figuring out their schedule, are from back east. If that is not working out looking into a similar local group.
- Same thing with V'ni Dansi.
- Axe Capoeira is booked for May 18.
- Green Thumb Theatre is booked for March 12.
- Theatre de la Sixième is booked for May 31.
- All programs are paid for after.
- Stationary bikes: crank mechanism is broken. Jean-Paul Carrier and Yves are looking into short cranks. And school is looking into different bikes.
- Giant Connect Four/Basketball Set/Supplementary Balls should come really fast as soon as they are ordered, depending on where it is ordered.
- Gymnastics for both primary and intermediate groups and not only primary kids because of equipment in the gym and prep time for intermediates which would be in the Gym.
- Two members of the tech committee, Mme Christine and Mme Renée, are coming to the PAC meeting to ask for gradually increasing the number of Mac laptops to get to a set for the upper intermediates. The existing PC's are not working well, are slow, and the hope is that with macs the kids can work more and better on projects at school, instead of at home.

Kateryna: is going to report about the assembly by l'equipe leadership and the club SOGI and a Grade 4 class.

## Finance update:

- There is a google doc with a summary of all the important finance information for the Quebec accounts, starting with Quebec 2020 and including Quebec Futures Fund. Doc contains Signatories names and current balance. Most Quebec accounts are closed. It got started to get an overview of what is in the accounts and that the treasurers have more of an overview without burdening them.
- Quebec 2017 still has an account with $\$ 6.29$ on it. Hard to get the former treasurers to close the account. Brenna had no success either, but we don't get the statements anymore. We're getting the documents to the one known treasurer, and formally document it in the meeting minutes PACs will to close this account.
- Casino account: money from the Casino grant has to be held in a separate account, can not be with the PAC money. In the process of changing the signatories over. One of the old signatories has to sign it off.


## Funding request for cage for PAC BBQ propane gas storage:

- 2 propane gas tanks are still on the porch of James Howey, across from the school. To be able to store them on the balcony, close to the PAC BBQ, we need a lockable cage. Julia is looking into getting one. We will need money for that cage, something in between $\$ 150$ to $\$ 500$.


## Funding request for fixing broken zipper of Tennyson banner:

- Zipper of the storage bag for the Tennyson banner is broken. Julia was looking into getting a new bag, but it seems to be very hard to find. Sunita is checking with a seamstress around the corner, how expensive it would be to get the zipper replaced. Trish lets Barbara know the name of a store which specializes in repairing things like that. Barbara will inquire how expensive it will be to get it fixed there.
