## JELLO EATING CONTEST

### Staff Room

A contest to see who consumes slime (jello) the fastest.

- 2 stamp to play; winner awarded 4 tickets (ties awarded 2 or 3 tickets each).
- Run Time: 6:30 to 9:00

*Staff*: One costumed Room Head, plus 1 helper for the door for each shift.

#### *Supplies*:

- 75 pkgs of jello (green, purple, orange, yellow and red)
- 12 five litre ice cream containers
- plastic flooring and tablecovers
- 250 cheap paper plates and napkins; garbage cans and extra bags
- tables from the staff room
- bingo stamper for door
- prize tickets for room head

#### *Preparations*:

- prepare jello on Tuesday before Howl (1 cup boiling water mixed with pkg jello, then 1 cup cold water – colors are usually mixed to look more disgusting); jello sets quickly in a fridge but will set in a cold, dry place (like a garage or covered on a deck)

*Set-up*: Decorate room . Jello is kept in the fridge in the staff room. Plastic sheeting on the floor protects the carpet. One long table and one short table, covered in plastic, for the contestants.

*How it Works*: Door volunteer stamps participants cards as they enter (about 12 guests per game). Dinner guests line up on either side of the table. Scoop out jello for everyone according to age – older kids receive more, younger kids less. For older kids, the first one finished is the winner and receives 4 tickets. For very young children, they get 2 tickets for finishing their plate.
