

# Updates to questions from PAC meeting- Jan 2022

## Construction, field and play space

### Sod vs. Seed

Sod is not recommended for installation on large swaths of land like the one we will be covering. The mesh apparently contributes to uneven surfaces and creates hazards in the field. Using sod is also problematic environmentally as it requires two months of intense watering (daily or even more frequently).

### What is being done to get the project back on track?

The Vancouver Project Office project manager meets with the site supervisor on a biweekly basis to monitor progress.

### Will there be compensation for delays?

Unlike private construction projects, there is no delay clause built into the contracts awarded for seismic mitigation/replacement in the VSB.

### Pop up plaza

When this idea was floated, the Project Office and the VSB approached the City. Permission was denied because of the Broadway Subway Project and concerns about traffic patterns being diverted by it.

## Covid-related information

### New student masks

We have a limited quantity in the office and received more from the District, but not enough to provide a replacement mask for each student. We have decided the best way to distribute will be to give students who come in to the office for a disposable mask a cloth one as well, if they wish.
